




Prevention of the spread of HLB in citrus cultivation

PRE-HLB is a project funded by the Horizon2020 Framework Programme whose objective is to prevent the entry of Huanglongbing disease (HLB) into Europe and, if it occurs, to prepare the necessary mechanisms for its effective control in the short, medium and long term.



New perspectives for the Huanglobing

The African citrus psyllium, *Trioza erytreae*, is an insect whose presence in a territory can produce a very high impact, both because of the direct damage it causes but mainly because of its role as a vector of the "Husalgongbing" disease (HEB) or citrus greening, currently considered as the main threat to these plants worldwide.
